Support Clean Energy and Earn Money for Your Community

Through National Grid's GreenUpSM program, you can support renewable energy right on your electric bill. By choosing to pay a bit extra each month, you can encourage the development of energy from renewable sources like the sun, wind, water, and biomass.

Because GreenUp partners with the Clean Energy Choice program, your support generates clean energy grants for your town or city.

Currently, some towns have earned over \$30,000 to buy solar panels for a school or public building. Below are some examples of how towns are using their matching grants for renewable energy projects:

Northhampton used \$53,000 to pay for a 10kW PV solar array for JFK Middle School.

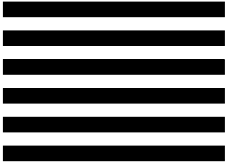
Andover, Brookline, Egremont, Gloucester, and a number of other towns purchased one or more BigBellySM solar trash compactors.

Worcester used \$36,000 to cover the costs of researching and producing an energy efficiency/renewable energy plan to address climate change.
