One-Time Turnkey Contract and Insurance Exemption for Licensed Electricians Minimum Requirements

MRET will waive the Turnkey Contract and Minimum Insurance Requirements for a PV project when:

- The PV installation will be performed by the applicant who is an electrician with a valid and current license issued by the Massachusetts Board of State Examiners of Electricians;
- The applicant represents and warrants that the PV installation is being performed on the applicant's primary residence and the applicant is the lawful owner of record of such residence;
- The applicant, at no additional cost to MRET, maintains a homeowner's policy with a minimum of \$1,000,000 in personal liability coverage. To the extent that the applicant's homeowner's policy does not provide the required coverage, the applicant can satisfy the \$1,000,000 minimum through a combination of coverage provided by the applicant's homeowner's policy and a personal umbrella for excess liability coverage. The insurance must be purchased from a company or companies authorized to do business in Massachusetts and having a rating of no less than A- (Excellent) from A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide; and
- The applicant complies with all other Commonwealth Solar Rebate Program requirements set forth in the Program Manual, including the Minimum Technical Requirements (Attachment D).
